Baku City is the capital and largest city of Azerbaijan, as well as the largest city on the Caspian Sea and of the Caucasus region. Baku is located 28 meters (92 ft) below sea level, which makes it the lowest lying national capital in the world and also the largest city in the world located below sea level. Baku lies on the southern shore of the Absheron Peninsula, alongside the Bay of Baku. Baku's urban population was estimated at two million people as of 2009. Baku is the primate city of Azerbaijan—it is the sole metropolis in the country, and about 25% of all inhabitants of the country live in Baku's metropolitan area.

Baku is divided into twelve administrative regions and 48 townships. Among these are the townships on the islands of the Baku Archipelago, and the town of Oil Rocks built on stilts in the Caspian Sea, 60 kilometers (37 miles) away from Baku. The Inner City of Baku, along with the **Shirvanshah's Palace** and **Maiden Tower**, were inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2000.

The city is the scientific, cultural, and industrial centre of Azerbaijan.

The city is renowned for its harsh winds, which is reflected in its nickname, the "City of Winds".

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• **Heydar Aliyev Center**

Our Baku sightseeing tour starts with visiting Heydar Aliyev Center. The cultural center of Heydar Aliyev which is considered as one of the symbols of modern Baku is a cultural center built on Heydar Aliyev Avenue in Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan. It includes an auditorium (congress center), a museum, exhibition halls and administrative offices. The project of the center was developed in 2007 by the architect Zaha Hadid. In 2014 it was recognized as the best building in the world – the 2014 Design of the Year award.

The Alley of Honor (Azerbaijani: Fəxri Xiyaban, Honorary Allée) is a public cemetery and memorial in Baku, Azerbaijan. The Alley includes burials of famed Azerbaijanis and Azerbaijan-affiliated expatriates, including several Presidents, scientists and artists. There are over 280 burials in total.

• Lunch in a restaurant with the cuisine preferred by you. After lunch we start our tour from Modern Baku.

• **Highland Park (Dag Ustu Park)** – Panoramic view of Baku Bay from the highest point of the city. Both locals and tourists come to the park to appreciate the view, take a stroll, or simply relax. Name Highland Park received due to its location. The territory of the parking zone is located on a hill, so from the observation platforms, a magnificent view of the nearby attractions opens Baku Boulevard, Baku Bay, the Shirvanshahs Palace, the Old City of Baku and the Maiden's Tower. The place is called by local people "Dagustu park" which means Upland Park.

• **Palace of Shirvanshahs.** Palace of Shirvanshahs – It is the historical monument of the Azerbaijan architecture, situated in the Inner City of Baku, named "**Icheri sheher**". The complex contains the main building of the palace, Divanhane, the mosque with a minaret and the remnants of the bath-house. The Maiden Tower is a 12th-century monument in the Old City, Baku, Azerbaijan. Along with the Shirvanshahs' Palace, dated to the 15th century, it forms a group of historic monuments listed in 2001 under the UNESCO World Heritage List of Historical Monuments as cultural property, Category III. It is one of Azerbaijan's most distinctive national emblems, and is thus featured on Azerbaijani currency notes and official letterheads. **Juma Mosque** – Located in the historic "Old City", the mosque has been rebuilt several times. The present Juma Mosque was built in 1899. The **Baku Museum of Miniature Books** is the only museum of miniature books in the world, settled in the old part of Baku, called Inner City. In 2015 the Museum of Miniature Books was presented the Certificate of the Guinness Book of Records as the largest private museum of miniature books.

• **Baku Boulevard**

"The Boulevard" was recently named as a national park. Its history goes back more than 100 years, to a time when oil barons built their mansions along the Caspian shore and when the seafront was artificially built up inch by inch.
