##### **DAY 1: Baku**

##### **DAY 2 : Baku**

**Baku – Heydar Aliyev Center, Alley of Honor, Highland Park, Icheri sheher, Baku Boulevard**

- Breakfast in hotel.

Baku City is the capital and largest city of Azerbaijan, as well as the largest city on the Caspian Sea and of the Caucasus region. Baku is located 28 meters (92 ft) below sea level, which makes it the lowest lying national capital in the world and also the largest city in the world located below sea level. Baku lies on the southern shore of the Absheron Peninsula, alongside the Bay of Baku. Baku's urban population was estimated at two million people as of 2009. Baku is the primate city of Azerbaijan—it is the sole metropolis in the country, and about 25% of all inhabitants of the country live in Baku's metropolitan area.

Baku is divided into twelve administrative regions and 48 townships. Among these are the townships on the islands of the Baku Archipelago, and the town of Oil Rocks built on stilts in the Caspian Sea, 60 kilometers (37 miles) away from Baku. The Inner City of Baku, along with the **Shirvanshah's Palace** and **Maiden Tower**, were inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2000.

The city is the scientific, cultural, and industrial centre of Azerbaijan.

The city is renowned for its harsh winds, which is reflected in its nickname, the "City of Winds".

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Our Baku sightseeing tour starts with visiting Heydar Aliyev Center

• **Heydar Aliyev Center**

Our Baku sight seeing tour starts with visiting Heydar Aliyev Center. The cultural center of Heydar Aliyev which is considered as one of the symbols of modern Baku is a cultural center built on Heydar Aliyev Avenue in Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan. It includes an auditorium (congress center), a museum, exhibition halls and administrative offices. The project of the center was developed in 2007 by the architect Zaha Hadid. In 2014 it was recognized as the best building in the world – the 2014 Design of the Year award.

**The Alley of Honor** (Azerbaijani: Fəxri Xiyaban, Honorary Allée) is a public cemetery and memorial in Baku, Azerbaijan. The Alley includes burials of famed Azerbaijanis and Azerbaijan-affiliated expatriates, including several Presidents, scientists and artists. There are over 280 burials in total.

• Lunch in a restaurant with the cuisine preferred by you. After lunch we start our tour from Modern Baku.

• **Highland Park (Dag Ustu Park)** – Panoramic view of Baku Bay from the highest point of the city. Both locals and tourists come to the park to appreciate the view, take a stroll, or simply relax. Name Highland Park received due to its location. The territory of the parking zone is located on a hill, so from the observation platforms, a magnificent view of the nearby attractions opens Baku Boulevard, Baku Bay, the Shirvanshahs Palace, the Old City of Baku and the Maiden's Tower. The place is called by local people "Dagustu park" which means Upland Park.

• **Palace of Shirvanshahs.** Palace of Shirvanshahs – It is the historical monument of of the Azerbaijan architecture, situated in the Inner City of Baku, named "**Icheri sheher**". The complex contains the main building of the palace, Divanhane, the mosque with a minaret and the remnants of the bath-house The Maiden Tower is a 12th-century monument in the Old City, Baku, Azerbaijan. Along with the Shirvanshahs' Palace, dated to the 15th century, it forms a group of historic monuments listed in 2001 under the UNESCO World Heritage List of Historical Monuments as cultural property, Category III. It is one of Azerbaijan's most distinctive national emblems, and is thus featured on Azerbaijani currency notes and official letterheads. **Juma Mosque** – Located in the historic "Old City", the mosque has been rebuilt several times. The present Juma Mosque was built in 1899 The **Baku Museum of Miniature Books** is the only museum of miniature books in the world, settled in the old part of Baku, called Inner City. In 2015 the Museum of Miniature Books was presented the Certificate of the Guinness Book of Records as the largest private museum of miniature books.

• **Baku Boulevard**

"The Boulevard" was recently named as a national park. Its history goes back more than 100 years, to a time when oil barons built their mansions along the Caspian shore and when the seafront was artificially built up inch by inch.

### **DAY 3: Guba Tours**

Morning departure to the northern part of Azerbaijan – Quba region. Visit one of most ancient settlements in the country – Khinalug or Xinaliq (210 km, 3-4 hours). The road to Khinalug is a picturesque mountain pass at an altitude of 2,000 m. Enjoy breathtaking views of the landscape. People have been continuously living in Khinalug for more than 5,000 years. On the way back, stop in Quba and visit Sakina Khanim Mosque, medieval bath hammam, and carpet workshop.

### **DAY 4: Guba**

Today we can visit Gusar

Gusar city is the last major settlement in the north part of Azerbaijan. It is called “The North Gates” due to its geographical location as it borders with the Republic of Dagestan of the Russian Federation. Population of the region consists of Lezgins – an original nationality, with a rich culture, characterized by hospitality. Gusar is famous for Summer-Winter touristic complex – Shahdag, operating all year round. In winter it is a popular ski resort, and in summer – a camp site in the slope of the Greater Caucasus Mountains. Part of the Gusar territory is included to the Shahdag National Park – the largest in Azerbaijan. Cultural life of this region is very rich. There are a lot of musical collectives, the most popular is the folklore ensemble called “Lezginka”. “Lezginka” is a popular national dance in the entire Caucasus, performed accompanied by accordion and national percussion instrument – “nagara”.

Qabala (Gabala) is a unique and beautiful region, located on the bank of Demiraparanchay River & overlooking the highest peak of Azerbaijan – Bazarduzu mountain (altitude 4466 m). Modern infrastructure of hotels & resorts provides high level of services that will satisfy needs of worldly-wise tourists. Every summer Gabala hosts international festivals, which attract famous musicians, artists & art collectives from all over the world.

Leaving hotel and go to Absheron peninsule. In here you will visit:

**Ateshgah Temple**– The temple of fire worshippers Ateshgah is located at the Absheron peninsula at the outskirts of Surakhani village in 30 km from the centre of Baku and was revered in different times by Zoroastrians, Hindus and Sikhs. This territory is known for such unique natural phenomenon as burning natural gas outlets (underground gas coming onto surface contacts oxygen and lights up).

**Qala Archaeological and Ethnographic Museum Complex**– The Gala state archaeological and ethnographic museum complex is considered one of the most interesting tourist sites in Baku. One can see the burial mounds, tombs, houses, constructions, water storages, the ruins of an ancient castle, five mosques, three baths and others in the territory of this complex. All this was discovered on the Absheron Peninsula and related to the period from the third millennium BC to the twentieth century. The first archaeological and ethnographic complex in the open air was established in 2008 to preserve these monuments, as well as to replenish them as a result of the archaeological excavations in Absheron.

**Yanardag (Burning Mountain)**- One of the most famous and popular tourist places of the “eternal flame” in Azerbaijan is the mountain of Yanar Dag. Actually, it is rather a hill than a mountain, with natural gas burning on its slope from ancient times. Meterlong tongues of fire are licking the stratified earth approximately for 10 m in width, searing those who approached too close. People occupy the benches to watch the blazing hill in the
